Entries must be the work of the entrant and must not have been accepted for publication. Manuscripts must show no name or address, just the title. All identification details should be on this entry form - 1 entry per form. Copyright remains with the author. Entries cannot be returned. No corrections accepted or refunds given. A completed entry form must accompany all entries. Results of the Competition will only be published on the Yeovil Literary Prize website. [www.yeovilprize.co.uk](http://www.yeovilprize.co.uk). Entries not complying with competition rules will be disqualified. The decision of the judges is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
