**Prizes** - 1<sup>st</sup> = £1,250 : 2<sup>nd</sup> = £300 : 3<sup>rd</sup> = £125

**SHORT STORY** - Up to a maximum of 2,000 words. **Prizes** - 1<sup>st</sup> = £600 : 2<sup>nd</sup> = £250 : 3<sup>rd</sup> = £125

**POETRY** - A poem with a maximum of 40 lines. **Prizes** - 1<sup>st</sup> = £600 : 2<sup>nd</sup> = £250 : 3<sup>rd</sup> = £125

**WRITING WITHOUT RESTRICTION** - **Prizes** - 1<sup>st</sup> = £250 : 2<sup>nd</sup> = £125 : 3<sup>rd</sup> = £75

The judging team will be the Yeovil Community Arts Association together with our guest judges for 2021

### Competition Rules

Entries must be in English, single-sided, and double-spaced. (Poetry single-spaced). Pages should be numbered. A word count must be given at the end of the novels and short story. Novels must not be stapled. Entries must be the work of the entrant and must not have been accepted for publication. Manuscripts must show no name or address, just the title. All identification details should be on this entry form - 1 entry per form. Copyright remains with the author. Entries cannot be returned. No corrections accepted or refunds given. A completed entry form must accompany all entries. For acknowledgement of entry send an SAE marked 'acknowledgement'. Results of the Competition will only be published on the Yeovil Literary Prize website. Entries not complying with competition rules will be disqualified. The decision of the judges is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
